



Spay & Neuter Clinic Information

To Schedule an appointment, call (434) 985-3203

Thank you for being a caring and responsible pet owner and spaying/neutering your pet! You are making a positive difference in your pet's happiness and health, while also decreasing companion pet over-population.

Important Feeding Instructions: Adult cats and dogs cannot have any food after 11:00pm the night before surgery. Puppies or kittens under 6 months of age should have a small meal before being dropped off for surgery.

Important: Animals must be healthy to undergo surgery. If your pet is showing any signs of illness (coughing, sneezing, runny eyes, diarrhea) they will be declined for surgery. See your veterinarian for care first, and then re-schedule surgery when your pet is well.

Dropping Off Your Pet for Surgery:

1. Please drop off between 7:00am – 8:00am

*It is very important that you arrive between these times. Please be aware that **we close the clinic at 8:00am so that we can begin surgeries** to allow the animals sufficient recovery time so they will be ready to be picked up in the afternoon. We do charge a no-show fee of \$5.00 for a missed appointment if you do not call us ahead of time.*

2. Payment is made when you drop off your pet. Checks and cash only please.

3. Virginia law requires all animals to be vaccinated for rabies. If your pet needs a rabies vaccination, it will be \$10.00, otherwise please bring your vaccination records with you when you drop off your pet.

3. All cats must be in separate carriers. Please clearly label your carrier with your last name. If you do not have a carrier, you may rent one from us for \$3.00 per day.

4. All dogs must be on leashes. Any dogs showing signs of aggression will be declined for surgery.

Picking Up Your Pet After Surgery:

1. Please pick between 4:30pm – 5:00pm

Note that additional charges will occur for late pick-ups or special arrangements.

Vaccinations: \$10.00 (only provided at time of surgery – not offered as separate service)
